BOOKINGS/RESERVATIONS

May be made up to one (1) year in advance

May have one (1) reservation in the reservation system at a time

May not schedule reservations from April 15 - June 15 and September 15 - October 31

May fish on designated open water beats and one (1) beat day on Guide Required and Guide Optional Beats per year

Guide always required on Guide Optional and Guide Required Beats

May fish unlimited number of days on Open Water Beats

All Guests to the club must be accompanied by a member

ESCAPE SEASONS ARE JANUARY 1 - APRIL 14, JUNE 16 - SEPTEMBER 14, NOVEMBER 1 - DECEMBER 31.

\$500 total for half day guided access day includes half day guide fee (\$400), plus \$100 to cover additional beat of water being used by splitting full day into halves.

Little J is the only Open Water Beat that does not require a guest fee for one guest per day. Normal guest fees will be charged on all other beats.

Open and Premium Open beats do not require a guide.
Scheduling is always required on all beats.

Sporting Clays

Traditional Five Stand & Flurry Field.

Introduction to Sporting Clays (1 Hour) = \$99

Designed for those interested in trying sporting clays for the first time. This package offers instruction in firearm safety and range etiquette, shotgun mechanics, and fundamentals of sporting clays. Shooters will be provided with a firearm, safety gear and ammunition in this one-hour experience.

Level I Lesson (1 Hour) = \$149

Geared towards the shooter with experience but looking to become more proficient in sporting clays. We will look at various methods of acquiring lead, understanding proper gun fit and eye dominance, managing recoil and the establishment of a pre-shot routine to raise scores and develop as a shooter.

Level II Lesson (1 Hour) = \$199

This is for an established shooter who needs in-depth instructions on specific targets presentations, eye dominance issues or basic shooting fundamentals. We will look at establishing a "Hard Focus" on targets and creating a more fluid shooting technique as well as the psychology of breaking tough targets routinely.
