BOOKINGS/RESERVATIONS

Reservations may be made up to three hundred sixty-five (365) days in advance and you may have six (6) reservations in the system at a time from April 15 – June 15 and September 15 - October 31

Other times of the year, you may book up to one (1) year in advance and have no restrictions on the number of reservations, beyond the number of days your membership provides

Member Designees can be certified to fish unguided for “Access Days”

Access Day not required for January and February Fishing Reservation

Sporting Clays

Introduction to Sporting Clays (1 Hour) = \$99

Designed for those interested in trying sporting clays for the first time. This package offers instruction in firearm safety and range etiquette, shotgun mechanics, and fundamentals of sporting clays. Shooters will be provided with a firearm, safety gear and ammunition in this one-hour experience.

Level I Lesson (1 Hour) = \$149

Geared towards the shooter with experience but looking to become more proficient in sporting clays. We will look at various methods of acquiring lead, understanding proper gun fit and eye dominance, managing recoil and the establishment of a pre-shot routine to raise scores and develop as a shooter.

Level II Lesson (1 Hour) = \$199

This is for an established shooter who needs in-depth instructions on specific targets presentations, eye dominance issues or basic shooting fundamentals. We will look at establishing a "Hard Focus" on targets and creating a more fluid shooting technique as well as the psychology of breaking tough targets routinely.
